

PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

UNYQ works to ensure that your privacy is protected when using our services. We therefore have a policy setting out how your personal data will be processed and protected. Please stay updated to any changes to this Privacy Policy by visiting our website.

This Privacy Policy only concerns UNYQ customers and users of our online services.

Where is your personal data stored?

The data that we collect from you is stored within the database of the company which might be accessed by third party companies with the same privacy policy.

What types of personal data do we collect?

We will collect personal data that you submit to us, for example, when you register or create a new account, when you make an order or when you contact our customer service. The personal data that you submit to us may for example include contact information, billing information and contact details.

To what does the app UNYQ Armor™ need access?

- a) The application sends the pictures taken in the background, even though the application closes after placing the order. This feature uses battery and Wifi / 4G / 3G connection while it is running.
- b) For the correct operation of the ordering process, the location of the device needs to be activated. Location data is not public or accessible by either developers nor third parties.
- c) The information collected is stored in our database, following this privacy policy.

How do we use your personal data?

We may use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To create and manage your personal account at UNYQ
- To process your orders via our online services
- To send through the App notifications of delivery status
- To contact you in the event of any problems with your orders
- To answer your queries and to inform you of new or changed services
- To send marketing offers such as newsletters and catalogues
- To notify the winners in competitions arranged online
- To manage your account
- To make analyses in order to provide you with relevant marketing offers and information

- To send you surveys in order to give you a possibility to influence our offer and services
- To test and improve our systems by which the services are provided
- To prevent misuse or improper use of our services

We will keep your data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes above or for as long as we are required by law. After this your personal data will be deleted.

What are your rights?

You have the right to request information about the personal data we hold on you at any time (free of charge once a year). If your data is incorrect, incomplete or irrelevant, you can ask to have the information corrected or removed. We cannot remove your data when there is a legal storage requirement, such as book-keeping rules or when there are other legitimate grounds to keep the data, such as unsettled debts. You can withdraw your consent to us using the data for marketing purposes at any time. You can contact us by sending an email to hello@unyq.com. Who has access to your personal data?

Your data may be shared within the UNYQ group. We never pass on, sell or swap your data for marketing purposes to third parties outside the UNYQ group. Data that is forwarded to third parties, is only used to provide you with the services mentioned above, for example shipping agents in connection with the delivery of goods, media agencies for distribution of newsletter and credit reference or debt collection agencies for the purpose of credit rating checks, identity checks and debt collection.

How do we protect your personal data?

We have taken technical and organisational measures to protect your data from loss, manipulation, unauthorised access. We continually adapt our security measures in line with technological progress and developments. This means that the information is passed through a secure connection and that your personal data cannot be read by external parties.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is saved to, and, during subsequent visits, retrieved from your computer or mobile device. UNYQ uses cookies to enhance and simplify your visit. We do not use cookies to store personal information, or to disclose information to third parties.

We use permanent cookies to store your details if you stay logged in. We use session cookies when you use the product filtration function, to check whether you are logged in or if you put an item in your shopping bag.

You can easily erase cookies from your computer or mobile device using your browser. For instructions on how to handle and delete cookies please look under "Help" in your browser. You can choose to disable cookies, or to receive a

notification each time a new cookie is sent to your computer or mobile device. Please note that if you choose to disable cookies, you will not be able to take advantage of all our features.

Third-party cookies

We use third-party cookies to collect statistics in aggregate form in analysis tools such as Google Analytics. The cookies used are both permanent and temporary cookies (session cookies). The permanent cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device for no longer than 24 months.

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
